- Philippians 2:9-11 is an early Christian hymn of praise to God. What do these words say about the Lord whom we serve?

Print these out and attach them to a piece of poster board. Write the words "Jesus is Lord" at the top of the poster. Hang the poster somewhere where you will all see it every day.
