

LEARNER SHEET: DELIVERANCE

Exodus 15:1-18



THE BIG IDEA

God promises to save us
from evil now and forever.

BIG FUN IDEA

Have a video marathon
night. Get some beanbags,
rent movies, make popcorn,
and watch movies.

BIG SERVING IDEA

Brainstorm things your
group could deliver that
would demonstrate our
belief that God delivers us
from evil and adversity.
Prepare a simple meal and
deliver it to someone in the
congregation who has a
new baby, has been recently
hospitalized, or is unable to
leave his or her home. The
pastor should have names
of people who would
appreciate your “delivery.”

Remember your partner's prayer needs—record them here.

DISCUSSION TIME

- Look around the world. Where are some of the places you see people in need of deliverance?

- What would deliverance look like for the people and places you just named?

- Tell about a time when you were rescued or saved from a bad or even dangerous situation.

LEARNER TAKE-HOME SHEET: DELIVERANCE

Exodus 15:1-18



Take this sheet home and keep it someplace near the dinner table like on the fridge. At least three times next week at dinner, use Prayer Time and one other family activity to make your confirmation learning come alive!

PRAYER TIME

God of deliverance, we are overwhelmed by the pain and suffering around us and within us. Show us your mercy, O God. Show us the path out of idle confusion and into a life spent seeking you. In Jesus name. Amen

TALK TIME

- Think about the people who deliver things to your home, like the mail carrier and the paper delivery person. Say a prayer for their protection.
- How has evil touched your family? Have you ever talked about how you get through hard times? Look through pictures of older relatives and talk about the challenges they faced in their lives.
- How does God feel when a natural disaster occurs that destroys God's people? As you listen to the news or read the paper, talk about this question.

WEB TIME

Gather around the family computer and use an Internet search engine to search for the key words. Write down the most interesting site you find that pops up for each term. Then do a search for "evil." What do you find? Explore five sites that mention the term, and discuss the various opinions and perspectives you find. What are they trying to say? What kind of organizations do you think built the sites? Discuss.
