

LEARNER TAKE-HOME SHEET:

JUDAH (PART 2)

Jeremiah 31:31-34; 7:1-15, 23-26; Hebrews 8;

Romans 3:21-24; Exodus 20



Take this sheet home and keep it someplace near the dinner table like on the fridge. At least three times next week at dinner, use Prayer Time and one other family activity to make your confirmation learning come alive!

PRAYER TIME

Gracious God, we give you thanks for the faithful people with whom we have contact every day. We pray for _____ (insert names). Continue to show love and mercy to all people, that they might know your eternal commitment to them. In Jesus' name, Amen

TALK TIME

- In what ways do we see the Holy Spirit working in our faith community? How does our faith community seek to live among God's faithful people? Identify the things that our church does to help others.
- Talk about the power of forgiveness to make you feel better. Write the things you have done to another family member for which you would like to ask forgiveness.
- What does it mean to live in exile? Who in the world lives in exile because of war, poverty, or dictatorship? How can we help?
- What actions can our families take in our neighborhood to share faith with others?

WEB TIME

As a family, do an Internet search for these key words: *sin*, *forgiveness*, *prophet*, and *covenant*. What different definitions of these words do you find? What is the most interesting site? Discuss the three most interesting Web sites and determine whether or not they are helpful for learning to live among God's faithful people.

RITUAL TIME

Write a family covenant (agreement) that highlights ways in which family members can live faithfully with one another (*pray for one another, read the Bible together, help one another with chores, respect one another's privacy, etc.*). Ask everyone to sign the covenant, and put it in a place where all family members will see it.

KEY WORDS
