

LEARNER TAKE-HOME SHEET: WILDERNESS TO LAND

Exodus 16–18; Deuteronomy 1–6; Joshua 1–3, 24



Take this sheet home and keep it someplace near the dinner table like on the fridge. At least three times next week at dinner, use Prayer Time and one other family activity to make your confirmation learning come alive!

PRAYER TIME

Invite the group to stand and form a circle (hold hands if comfortable doing so), while you pray this prayer.

Father God, we thank you for the chance to get together and learn more about your faithfulness and how you provided for the children of Israel. We thank you that you are faithful to us, even when we're not faithful to you. Give us the strength today to commit to following you, regardless of what other people say, or think, or do. In your name we pray, Amen.

TALK TIME

- Read Joshua 24:14-15 and talk about what it means to fear the Lord and serve the Lord with faithfulness.
- Have everyone mention one way that God provides for them. Encourage each person to come up with a new idea so there are no repeats.
- Keep a journal this week of times when you recognized God providing for you. Note especially how that made you feel. Consider sharing the journal with the family.



KEY WORDS

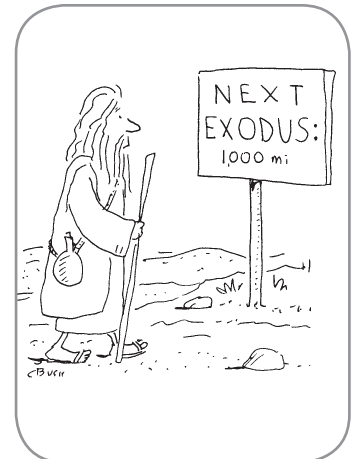
Keep a family white board someplace near the dinner table, and write these words on it. Try writing a family definition for each one during the week.
