

# LEARNER TAKE-HOME SHEET: CREED OVERVIEW



Take this sheet home and keep it someplace near the dinner table like on the fridge. At least three times next week at dinner, use Prayer Time and one other family activity to make your confirmation learning come alive!

## PRAYER TIME

Invite God into your presence by celebrating and lifting up the people and circumstances that dwell deep in your heart this week. Pray this prayer together:

**God, we praise your name and thank you for your grace and love. We ask today that we might better share abundant love with others. Grant us your peace that we might be peacemakers. We ask all of this in Jesus' name. Amen**



## KEY WORDS

Keep a family white board someplace near the dinner table, and write these words on it. Try writing a family definition for each one during the week.

## TALK TIME

Talk about these questions:

- What do you think are the very basics of the Christian faith?
- How do we learn about our faith?
- A creed is a statement of belief. Does your family have a creed?
- Christians believe that there is one God in three persons. How does it change the way we look at the world to believe that there is only one God?



## WEB TIME

The creeds give us the basics of the faith into which we have all been baptized. Gather around the family computer and have each person find an image or two of things that reflect what the church means to them. Print these out. Attach the pages you have printed on a piece of string or yarn in any order. Save space at the bottom of the string to attach a copy of the Apostles' Creed. Hang the list next to an outside door so that everyone will see it going out.

## RITUAL TIME

Have each member of the family make a copy of the Apostles' Creed that they can carry with them during their day. As part of your devotions, recite the words of the Apostles' Creed together.
