

# LEARNER TAKE-HOME SHEET: THE LAST SUPPER

Matthew 26:20-29; Mark 14:12-16; Luke 22:14-38



## KEY WORDS

Take this sheet home and keep it someplace near the dinner table like on the fridge. At least three times next week at dinner, use Prayer Time and one other family activity to make your confirmation learning come alive!

## PRAYER TIME

**Lord Jesus, thank you for becoming the Passover lamb that was sacrificed for us. Help us to be as forgiving to others as you are to us. We thank you that we are promised forgiveness of sin when we take Communion. Help us to always remember what it means for us. In your name we pray. Amen**

## TALK TIME

- Talk about what life might have been like during the time of the exodus. What would you like about it? What wouldn't you like? Would it be an easy life to live or a hard one? Explain why.
- Talk about the role forgiveness plays in your family. When is it easy to forgive a family member? When is it difficult? How does it feel to be forgiven? How does it feel to forgive?
- Share with each other what you can do to share God's love and forgiveness to a classmate or a coworker.
- What helps you feel that you're really an important part of your family? Of God's family?

## WEB TIME

Use an Internet search engine to look up the following key words: *Passover*, *forgiveness*, *salvation*, and *covenant*. Choose an article from each of these key words and read more about it. Did you learn something new from the articles? How are the words used in different ways?

## RITUAL TIME

Turn in your Bible to Luke 22:31-32 and read it aloud. Take turns inserting your name instead of Simon's name as you read the verses. How does it make you feel to hear your name? How does it make you feel to know that Jesus prays for you that your faith will remain strong?
